To exhibit exemplary conduct at practices, games, tournaments and/or any other functions that will represent AFC.

To wear all approved coaches training and game apparel

To coach clean, skillful, and honest soccer.

To stress playing hard to win as a team over the winning itself.

To work hard on team morale and team concepts.

To maximize positive reinforcement and constructive feedback.

To minimize criticism or destructive feedback of players.

To properly plan every practice to be instructive as well as Fun.

To treat referees with respect no matter what the call!

To exhibit good sportsmanship win, lose or draw.

Lead by positive example

To give the team their all.

To work with Team Manager to coordinate team operations and activities.

To address concerns of parents fairly and appropriately.

To involve team parents in all decisions regarding financial obligations (i.e., uniforms, tournaments, travel, parties, team building, etc.) Please remember players join anticipating a set Academy fee. Any additional team cost should be discussed openly with parents.

To attend all scheduled AFC coaching classes when possible and continue focus on licensing classes, when appropriate

To participate in all coaches' meetings and abide by AFC & OS By-Laws and Expectations.

Arrived 15 minutes before practice with your sessions set up and ready to begin training

Arrived 30 minutes before games at all times

Coaches must use Athletic Football Club training Material at all times but are encourage to add their own tweaking if needed here and there but must not change it completely.

Game assignment/ schedule may change so please be flexible

Coaches must attend all schedule games and practices unless otherwise arranged with the Academy Director.

Coaches must check their players attendance on TEAM APP in advance at least 4 hours prior and 2 hours prior for every practices or games in case call ups are required for a game.

Coaches must call the academy director directly if their player attendance to low for games to get call ups.

Coaches must be engaging in their training sessions with their players and in full control of their sessions.

Coaches must attend all schedule coaches and parents meeting

Athletic Football Club coaching Material cannot be share with other non-coach/clubs or any organization outside of AFC

Coaches are task with the developmental responsibility of their players / teams, which the Academy Director will access the coach on a constant basis to see how well he is progressing.

Coaches must not address parents directly all communications between coaches and parents must go through the academy Administrator, team manager, and or director
