Discipline Policies

A. Program adherence

The Club will apply the Discipline by Review (DBR) process for all cases in accordance with OSA Published Rules. In certain instances, a Hearing may be required, and appropriate parties will be notified. Detailed information about the DBR, DBH, and Special Incident Report systems is included in the Coaches Package.

B. Right to hear

Players have the right to request a hearing (DBH). A written request must be received no later than 72 hours after the date of the game.

C. Standard penalties

The Club will implement OSA Standard Penalties for Misconduct. These penalties are available in the Coaches Package and on the OSA website at www.soccer.on.ca (Published Rules – Discipline).

D. Failure to Appear

Failure to appear at a hearing will result in an immediate suspension from all soccer activities. The accused must submit a written request to schedule a discipline hearing.

E. Initiation of suspensions

All suspensions commence upon formal notification from the Club.

F. Game participation during suspension.

Any player or team official listed on a game sheet is deemed to have participated in that game. Participants who play while suspended are subject to disciplinary action, which may include forfeiture of the game.

G. Forfeit risk for unlisted players.

A team using a player not listed on the game sheet will face disciplinary action, including potential forfeiture of the game.
